







# The Nicest Sudoku

Fill the 9 by 9 grid on the next page with numbers from 1 to 9 such that all of the following six constraints are satisfied:

<p>The numbers in each row are distinct.</p> 	<p>The numbers in each column are distinct.</p> 
<p>The numbers in each box are distinct.</p> 	<p>The numbers in each relative position of the boxes are distinct.</p> 
<p>The numbers in the three mini-rows in the same relative position of the three boxes in each column are distinct.</p> 	<p>The numbers in the three mini-columns in the same relative position of the three boxes in each row are distinct.</p> 


Once you have done so, submit your grid to HQ (via the Contact HQ form) as a string with numbers from left to right on each row, with the rows separated by slashes. For example, one possible submission may look like this:

123456789/234567891/345678912/456789123/567891234/678912345/789123456/891234567/912345678

even though it doesn't satisfy the given constraints.
